DOBERMANN BREED COUNCIL – CRITERIA FOR COMPLETION OF JUDGING LISTS

A3 BREED SPECIALIST

The applicant should send 9 copies of the questionnaire and 3 copies of certificates to the Secretary of the Club, when applying for proposal by the Club

This list contains persons who, as yet, have not been approved by The Kennel Club and who are considered by The Dobermann Breed Council to have sufficient knowledge of the Dobermann and experience of judging the breed to be recommended and supported to award CC's. These persons will be assessed by The Kennel Club when judging their first appointment. All applicants both breed and non-breed specialist, must have completed and fulfilled all the requirements for the 'B' list and must be included on the 'B' list, PLUS the following:

1. To have been twelve (12) years actively involved in the breed and have the support of the Dobermann Breed Council.
2. To have judged a minimum of fifty (50) Dobermann Breed classes at Open or Championship Shows plus at least one Dobermann Breed Club Open show. Breed Club Shows must be at least 150 miles apart.
3. To have judged Dobermanns at a minimum of ten (10) breed Open or Championship Shows with an adequate geographical spread.
4. To have judged a minimum of at least 175 Dobermanns (dogs in attendance).
5. To be included on a Dobermann Breed Council 'B' judging list.
6. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. (KC Policy 01.07.2001)
7. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. (KC Policy 01.07.2001)
- 7a To have attended a Conformation and Movement 'Hands On' Assessment conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited trainer and passed the assessment (KC Policy as of 01.07.2005).
8. To have attended at least one Dobermann Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice.
9. To have attended, completed and passed a judges assessment day/test, held specifically for Dobermann's. Organised by one of the DBC member Clubs and run to the agreed format.
10. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances – please give written explanation)
11. To have stewarded for 12 Days.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

ALL applicants for consideration to all judging lists are at the discretion of the member Club's of the Breed Council.

Any application form listing shows from 1990 onwards. ALL records must be complete, otherwise, the show will not be included.

Any application with shows prior to 1990, records which are incomplete, a 25% reduction will be made on the entry detail.
